The 15th edition of Detours is coming to an end, and it's been a champagne

The 15th anniversary of the Detours Festival took place from 10 July to 22 September 2024. This year's edition was a resounding success, marked by record attendance and impressive artistic diversity. More than ever, the festival has established itself as a key pillar of the urban dance scene.

The festival has showcased a wide variety of urban dance styles, and is now opening up to new audiences with the introduction of new categories: Electro, Swing, Juggling (circus)... We celebrated the festival's 15th anniversary on the roof of the Bourse, bringing together the festival's emblematic artists for an open stage and our partners.

In addition to the Detours Cyphers national selections, international selections were held in Central America (Costa Rica), Congo and Morocco. This broadened the scope of the festival to include talent from all over the world.

The 3rd edition of the Urban Dance Caravan, co-produced with the Théâtre National Wallonie-Bruxelles, was a resounding success. It drew an increasingly diverse audience from the pedestrianised streets of Brussels to the grand stage for the final of the Detours Cyphers.

The theatre is now stepping up its commitment by hosting the next edition on 13 September 2025.

The festival also presented world premieres: 'Boddies Unbound' (Rwanda, DRC and Zimbabwe) at the Théâtre Varia and the premiere of 'Winners' (FWB) with Raffinerie Charleroi Danse. Two 'Work in Progress' evenings were organised. The artists presented their work in progress and received prizes to help them continue production and finalise their works.

As part of 'Plaisir d'Été', organised by Brussels Major Events, we offered a series of pop-up street shows in different areas of Brussels.

Three street shows took place in emblematic locations:

- 1. *Place de l'Europe
- 2. *Place Sainte-Catherine*
- 3. *Place du Jeu de Balle* (in the Marolles district)

These events succeeded in bringing together a varied public, creating a festive and dynamic atmosphere.

Swing Qualification

The Swing Qualifier, held on the Plaisird d'été stage, was a great success with the general public and the Swing community.

Layers Show

In parallel with these activities, the 'Layers' show, presented by Jules Rosenwajn, winner of previous WIPs, took place. This contemporary performance attracted an audience of contemporary performance enthusiasts, and enriched the programme by offering innovative experiences in the urban space.





AFTERPARTY 200 GUESTS

The Detours 15th anniversary party took place on the roof of the Bourse, a symbolic place for us since our activities began at the foot of this building with street shows.

Around 200 people attended this memorable evening. The evening kicked off with an open stage featuring a number of emblematic Detours artists. Among them were MCs (Makyzarts), Beatboxers (Gaspard Herblot), contemporary dance performers (Yvan docteur Maboul) and breakdancers from all the world, who over put on breathtaking performances to create a festive and convivial atmosphere.

Afterwards, professional dancers, friends of Detours and Festival partners and amateurs danced together to choreographed routines in a convivial spirit.

The participants expressed their satisfaction and particularly appreciated the diversity of the artistic performances. All in all, the evening was a great success, exceeding our expectations in terms of attendance and atmosphere.

We look forward to repeating the experience and continuing to bring the spirit of Detours to life on the roof of Brussels.





Thanks Detours Quartiers, the to festival leaves the centre of Brussels to reach out to people in other municipalities. In this way, it reaches a public less familiar with artistic creation and brings together diverse audiences to bring them all the way to the Théâtre National for the Grand Finale.

This year we held a Detours Quartier in the Great Hall of Molenbeek with Charleroi/Danse as part of Molenfest, and another with AMO SESAME in the Bizet district.


September 19 and 20 were devoted to the Detours Festival's Detours Festival.

Over the course of the two evenings, 12 companies presented their work on the stage of the CC Bruegel to members of the Belgian and French choreographic scene, who were partners in the event, and to the Detours public, who all received their 'coup de cœur' awards.

This initiative enables artists to benefit from artistic support and tools for creation, development, production and communication.

Each year, the projects presented are selected by the Detours team following a call for applications, on the basis of quality, with a concern for representation of genres and cultures. This year our international partners included Summer Dance Forever (Netherlands).

The topics discussed at each table related to the distribution, production and communication of urban dance creations.

The debates led to some interesting exchanges, which will undoubtedly feed into the future work of the artists present.

Conceived and (co)built with the Théâtre National Wallonie-Bruxelles, the Urban Dance Caravan is a huge urban dance movement that crosses the city centre from square to square, taking us to the heart of the Théâtre National. Dancers from all over Belgium, Latin America and Africa (Congo DRC, Brazaville, Rwanda, Zimbabwe) performed on ephemeral stages, like so many stations on the pedestrian walkway, from Place de la Bourse to Place De Brouckère, before taking the crowd to the large stage of the Théâtre National for the final battle of the Detours Cyphers.
